


EnergyWise Weatherization Program

In partnership with

Mississippi Power Company and Gulf Coast Community Foundation

EnergyWise is a program geared toward helping low-income Mississippi Power customers reduce their energy costs by providing <u>free</u> weatherization improvements for homes that do not meet current energy efficient standards.



- 1. Be a Mississippi Power Customer
- 2. Own the home to be weatherized
- 3. The home must be your primary residence (homes constructed after 2000 ineligible)
- 4. Meet income requirements below

In addition, a member of the household must meet <u>one</u> of the following conditions:

- Be 65 years of age or older
- Receive public or private disability payments
- Have children in primary or secondary schools or younger
- Be in a home with a high energy burden

Gross Household Income by Residents:

For households larger than 8, add \$4,180 for each additional person

Checklist for information needed to complete application:

- 1. Government issued photo ID for all members of household over 18 years old
- 2. Social security card for all members of household over 18 years old
- 3. Proof of Residency (Warranty Deed and Utility Bill)
- 4. Documentation of all forms of income in the household
